



Case Study Chiswick, London

Site - Residential Site - Chiswick, London- Japanese Knotweed

Planning - N/A.

Problem - Residential garden contaminated with Japanese knotweed, mortgage refused by lender because of plant. The knotweed was present in an area used for composting.

IVM Solution - Careful removal of inert materials from the composting area by IVM trained staff, the remainder of the rotted material was spread in a contained area. IVM then implemented a 'FAST' System treatment to achieve full eradication. A 10 year IVM company guarantee and a 10 year bonded PCA (property Care Association) guarantee was issue on completion.
