



Case Study Malden, Essex

Site - Residential Site - Malden, Essex - Japanese Knotweed

Planning - N/A.

Problem - Residential garden contaminated with Japanese knotweed, mortgage refused by lender because of plant. Japanese knotweed was also present on the adjacent site.

IVM Solution - Implement IVM 'FAST' System on both sites to achieve full eradication. A 10 year IVM company guarantee and a 10 year bonded PCA (Property Care Association) guarantee were issue on completion, allowing the mortgage to be approved.
