



Case Study Southampton & Portsmouth

Site - Various Sites - Southampton & Portsmouth

Planning - N/A

Problem - A large housing association within numerous properties in the South of England award IVM the treatment contract to eradicate the Japanese knotweed on 16 of their residential, commercial and public open spaces sites. Sites ranged from back gardens to car parks and wooded areas. Some sites were treated using a stem injection method, others using knapsack application.

IVM Solution - Implementation of IVM 'FAST' System to eradicate Japanese knotweed. A three year treatment program was put in place on all 16 sites.

Site visits and treatments continue throughout the growing season, with Site Progress Reports being sent to the client on a monthly basis. Regular monitoring visits have been carried out since the guarantees were issued - no re-growth of Japanese knotweed has been found on any of the sites.
